Maria STRATIGAKI is currently Assistant Professor and Director of the Centre for Gender Studies at the Department of Social Policy, Panteion University. She teaches gender and social policy, gender equality policies and European social policy. She is scientific responsible of the project "Gender Studies in Political and Social Sciences (2003-2008)" (www.genderpanteion.gr) and member of the European research team MAGE (Marché du travail et Genre) at IRESKO-CNRS (www.mage.cnrs.fr).

She has participated in research on women's work, gender and technology, gender in the labour market and gender equality policies. She was scientific responsible for the research project EQUAPOL (women's friendly public policies) funded by the EU FP5 Research Programme (www.equapol.gr) and conducted research on migration, social policy and gender at the Centre for Social Policy and Social Morphology, KEKMOKOP (www.kekmokop.gr)

Maria STRATIGAKI has studied economics, sociology and women's studies in Athens (University of Athens), Paris (Paris IX, Paris VII) and New York (NYU). She holds a Doctorate Degree in sociology of work (1994) (title of thesis: Computerisation and gender division of labour. The case of the National Bank of Greece). She has worked in business from 1974-1987, in the women's research centre "Diotima" from 1988-1991, and in the European Commission (DG V- Equal Opportunities Unit) from 1991-1999. Her tasks included actions promoting women in the decision-making and the design of EU gender mainstreaming strategy. From 1999-2002, she was the Director of the Research Centre for Gender Equality (KETHI) in Greece. Her tasks included coordination of studies and the development of positive actions in favour of women and gender mainstreaming in the Community Support Framework (2000-2006). She has organised Counselling Centres for unemployed women.

She is author of articles and books on gender and technology, gender and social policy, women's work and the European social policy. She has edited a collective volume on women's entrepreneurship and co-edited one on family policies. Her recent articles include:
